Hemoglobin A1C	Tests for sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
Immunizations	Thermography;
Lipid panel	Two hours post-load plasma glucose test;
Mammogram	Ultrasound screening of the abdominal aorta for abdominal aortic aneurysms
Oral cancer screening;	Ultrasounds for cancer detection;
Pap smears or thin prep pap test	Virtual colonoscopy.
